# THE EVENING'S SPEAKER

## **Travis Engen**

Travis Engen is President and Chief Executive Officer of Alcan Inc., a US\$25 billion organization headquartered in Montreal, Canada. Mr. Engen assumed this position on March 12, 2001. He has served on the Board of Alcan since 1996 and previous to becoming Alcan's CEO had been Chairman of the Personnel Committee as well as a member of the Corporate Governance Committee.



Mr. Engen began his career in 1965 with Bell Aerospace advancing to be director of electronics marketing. In 1976, he was named director of marketing for Republic Electronic Industries Corp., a position he held until 1979. He then became director of government avionics at the Bendix Avionics Division. In 1983, Mr. Engen was appointed vice president and general manager of Bendix's General Aviation Avionics Division.

He joined ITT Corporation in 1985 as president and general manager, ITT Avionics. In 1987, he was selected as the president and CEO of ITT Defence. In 1991, he was elected as executive vice president of ITT Corporation, assuming responsibility for ITT's manufacturing businesses. In subsequent years, his responsibilities grew to include ITT's forest products, insurance, communications and information services divisions when ITT Industries was formed. In 1995, he was selected as its first chief executive. In 2004, he was honoured as Canada's International Executive of the Year.

Mr. Engen serves on the Boards of the Lyondell Chemical Company, Canadian Council of Chief Executives, and the Defense Board. He is Chairman of the International Aluminium Institute.

Mr. Engen is a graduate of the Massachusetts Institute of Technology (MIT) with a Bachelor of Science degree in aeronautics and astronautics. He has one daughter and enjoys vintage car racing.

## Mark S. Rudolph

Mark S. Rudolph is President of justenvironment, his own public affairs consulting firm that specializes in environmental matters. He has a number of clients, both large and small, and both corporate and ENGO, whom he assists in developing solutions to their government relations/public affairs challenges. A letter of greetings from Dr. Donald Chant will be read as part of the 35th Anniversary Celebration. In 1969 as the Chairman of the Department of Zoology at the University of Toronto, Dr. Chant provided guidance to Pollution Probe in its earliest days. Subsequently he was Provost of the University from 1975–



1980. In 1980 he was appointed Chairman and President of the Ontario Waste Management Corporation by Premier Davis.

During his career Dr. Chant was an advisor to President Lyndon Johnson's Council on Environmental Quality and was Chair of the Canadian Environmental Advisory Council. He was appointed an Officer of the Order of Canada in 1989 and elected to the Council of the Royal Canadian Institute in 1994.

# CELEBRATING POLLUTION PROBE'S 35TH ANNIVERSARY

### Monte Hummel

As a young boy Monte Hummel moved from Toronto to Whitedog Falls, Ontario, where his father worked in a hydro camp. There, Monte fell in love with the woods, hiking, and guiding fishermen on the English River to earn pocket money. Ten years after leaving, he revisited this river to discover it had been contaminated with mercury, leaving the Ojibway



community there in social and economic despair. This experience led directly to his lifelong career of environmental advocacy.

Monte attended the University of Toronto where he won the E.J. Sanford Gold Medal in Philosophy and earned his B.A. (1969), M.A. (1970), and M.Sc. in Forestry (1979). He worked his way through school as a wilderness canoe-tripping guide.

In 1969 Monte helped to found Pollution Probe of which he became Executive Director and later Chairman. In 1978, he joined World Wildlife Fund Canada as Executive Director, to become President in 1985. During his tenure WWF has helped remove 23 wildlife species from Canada's Species at Risk list.

A well known public speaker, Monte Hummel is author of over 100 articles, contributor to many book chapters, and author or editor of five books.

In April 2000 Monte was appointed an Officer of the Order of Canada, and in June 2001 he was awarded the J.B. Harkin Medal by the Canadian Parks and Wilderness Society "in recognition of over thirty years of dedicated service to the conservation of Canada's wilderness and wildlife."

Monte has two grown children, Robin and Doug, and lives with his wife Sherry near Beeton, Ontario.




