

#### Purpose:

Collect hard-to-recycle plastics at residential curbside


<u>Divert</u> plastics from landfills at a quality suitable for approved end markets (recycling or energy recovery)

Complement existing recycling programs





### An End-of-Life Solution for Hard-to-Recycle Plastics





When full, consumers place tied bags in regular recycling cart/bin.



Orange bags are picked up by regular haulers along with other recyclables.






Plastics are converted into valuable resources





Orange bags are baled and sent to suitable end markets









## Hefty® EnergyBag™ Pilot – Citrus Heights, CA



- 8,000 Hefty<sup>®</sup> EnergyBag<sup>™</sup> orange bags collected
- 6,000 lbs. of NRP diverted from landfill
- 512 gallons synthetic fuel oil
- > 85% of households said they would participate again
- Proved hard-to-recycle plastics can be collected at curbside and diverted from landfill



- ✓ Frozen potato bags

- ✓ Plastic cheese bags
- ✓ Plastic pet food bags
- ✓ Frozen fruit bags
- √ Frozen vegetable bags
- ✓ Candy wrappers
- ✓ Coffee pods (without coffee)
- ✓ Packing peanuts
- ✓ Plastics liners from powder mixes
- ✓ Microwavable pouches
- ✓ Plastic straws & stir sticks
- ✓ Juice pouches
- ✓ Plastic utensils
- ✓ All other hard-to-recycle plastics


# Do NOT collect these items in your orange bags:


